



Faith Equestrian COVID-19 Infection Control Plan

Standard Procedures

1. If any person, who comes on property, tests positive for COVID 19 or has been in contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID 19, they must inform us and the program will be shut down immediately for 14 days and possibly longer. If this happens, we will refund your money or give you the option to make it a donation to us.
 - Anyone who was on site at the time of possible exposure will be contacted immediately.
2. No one with signs or symptoms should come to the facility (please contact us at 843-621-2321 if this is the case, Hallie's cell).
3. Upon arrival, everyone will wash their hands for 20 seconds
4. Parents will drop off campers without leaving the car and pick them up. We will be forming a remind app group for parents to communicate with us via text. Please read all instructions and emails carefully so you do not miss anything!
5. For pickup, we ask that you remain in your car, if we are running late, we will send out a text notification
6. Campers must bring a sealed lunch container and drink. Both of these must be labeled clearly with the camper's name so they do not get mixed up.

Staff/Counselors

1. Instructors and Counselors will maintain social distancing as much as possible unless it becomes a violation of safety but will not be required to wear masks due to the risk of overheating.
2. Instructors will provide assistance to riders from the side or back as much as possible- avoiding standing directly in front of them as much as able.
3. Campers will be spaced out as much as possible when inside and will be instructed to refrain from touching one another.

Facility

1. Staff will disinfect all gate latches, cross tie snaps, hose ends, door knobs, light switches, ramp rail, etc, daily.
2. Disinfectants will follow the CDC recommendations.
3. Bathrooms and shared surfaces will be disinfected regularly throughout the opening hours
4. All cleaning will follow CDC guidelines.
5. Tack will be sanitized between riding groups and reins will be rotated

Note on Masks

Due to the nature of the activity (riding horses takes place in the heat and could put riders at risk of overheating), we will not be requiring campers or counselors to wear masks (they can wear them if they like). Georgia guideline #32 says to provide masks "as available and appropriate to the activity and location of campers within the camp facility." We do not believe mask wearing is appropriate due to the possibility of riders experiencing heat exhaustion or stroke. Social distancing will be maintained as much as possible between groups and because we keep a small camp with 8 participants and 4 counselors, we fall under the 20 person guideline that Governor Kemp has mandated to separate groups.

Horse Show on Friday

Our horse show on Friday will be set up to implement social distancing measures. We will allow each camper to have no more than two guests and will have designated seats spaced out around the arena. Upon arrival, you will be escorted to your designated spot where you can watch your rider in the show. After the show is over, we will set up socially distanced seating in the arena for our horse parts competition. If you would prefer not to attend, let us know and we can arrange for an option to watch via Zoom.
